Word	Definition
Sketch	a rough or unfinished drawing or painting, often made to assist in making a more finished picture.
Tone	he relative lightness or darkness of a colour
Tint	where an artist adds a colour to white to create a lighter version of the colour.
Shading	The representation of light and shade on a drawing. A very slight variation
Observation	To closely observe and monitor, the ability to notice things of significant detail.

- Ronald "Carl" Giles OBE (29 September 1916 – 27 August 1995), often referred to simply as Giles, was a cartoonist best known for his work for the British newspaper the Daily Express.
- His cartoon style was a single topical highly detailed panel, usually with a great deal more going on than the single joke.
- Diego Velázquez was one of the most important Spanish painters of the 17th century, a giant of Western art.
- He had a keen eye and a prodigious facility with the brush.
- His works often show strong modelling and sharp contrasts of light, resembling the dramatic lighting technique
