Word	Definition	<p>In Y1 & Y2, you learnt about colour mixing, blending & shading.</p> <p>In Y2, you learnt about two famous painters: Vincent Van Gogh & Pablo Picasso.</p>	
Pointillism	A style of painting based on dots.		
watercolour	A type of paint, thinned with water.		<div style="border: 2px dashed red; padding: 5px;"> <p>Pointillism is where small dots, rather than longer brush strokes, are used to make a picture. You can see the word point (another word for dot) in pointillism.</p> </div>
blend	Mix substances (paints).		
shade	Make lighter or darker.		<div style="border: 2px dashed blue; padding: 5px;"> <p>Pointillism was invented by French artists Georges Seurat (1859—1891) and Paul Victor Jules Signac (1863 – 1935) .</p> </div>
pure colour	A single colour not mixed or blended.		
primary colour	Red, yellow or blue.		<div style="border: 2px dashed red; padding: 5px;"> <p>The dots are made up of one pure colour that hasn't been mixed with any other colours.</p> </div>
