Word	Definition
Empire	a country whose ruler is an Emperor
Democracy	a form of government in which power rests with the people, either directly or through elected representatives
Olympics	a modern international sports competition, held once every four years
Myths	a traditional or legendary story, usually concerning some being or hero or event
Ruler	a person (as a king or queen) having supreme power over a nation
Citizen	person who is entitled to enjoy all the legal rights and privileges granted by a place they live

Y1 Use the words older, younger, order, past, present, future and years ago appropriately

Y2 Understand what a timeline is
 Name some significant people and significant events that lived or happened in the past
Y3 Plot the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age on a timeline.

Influence
Y1 Compare modern items to items from the past (toys)
 Identify items that are similar now and in the past (toys)
 Know that some events that happened a long time ago still happen today (Olympics)
Y2 Know that people can change how events happen or how other people behave
 Know what influence means

Civilisation
Y1 Describe a settlement from the past (Corfe Castle)
Y2 Describe how people organised events to make things better (Mary Seacole field hospital)

Power and Rule
Y1 Know that Britain has a Royal Family
 Name some members of the Royal family
Y2 Link power with being brave and not always being physically strong
 Discuss how all people have the ability to be powerful
 Describe how powerful actions can have a positive impact

Significant Events
Y1 Describe a greater number of past significant events
 Relate really important events to being remembered for a long time
Y2 Explain what the word 'significant' means
 Describe how certain events had an impact on society (Captain Cook sails to Australia)
Y3 Discuss how some events were so important that it's considered they need to be protected
